Makerere University in collaboration with the University of Nairobi, Sokoine University of Agriculture and University of Copenhagen are implementing a project entitled *“Enhancing the quality of graduates of Agriculture to meet tomorrow’s food security challenges (PREPARE-BSC project)*. The overall objective is to enable the partner universities to develop competent relevant high level human resources within agriculture, veterinary science and related fields (hereafter referred to as agriculture) to address food security as part of socio-economic development needs of the societies in Eastern Africa. The PREPARE- BSC project is funded by EU through ACP-EDULINK II program.

The TOT course will take place from the 21<sup>st</sup> -23<sup>rd</sup> of March 2016 at Grand Global Hotel, Kampala.
