Professor in the Department of Geography, Geo-Informatics and Climatic Sciences. He holds a Licence in Applied Physics (1983-1988) from Institut Supérieur Pédagogique de Bukavu, DR Congo, MSc in Environmental Sciences and PhD in Soil Science from Makerere University. He has been involved in several regional soil erosion studies, water balance studies to mitigate drought induced crop failure in the Lake Kyoga basin, and restoration of forests of East Africa and Indian Ocean Islands. He has carried out collaborative research in Uganda, Rwanda and D.R. Congo with IUCN and UNDP on soil erosion modelling in different ecosystems. He has published 90 papers on soil erosion, pollution loading, land-use/cover dynamics, carbon stock and efficiency of soil and water management. He has won 16 Collaborative Research Grants and undertaken 17 consultancies. He has supervised 56 Masters and 3 PhDs.
