**Prof Andrew Barkley
Distinguished Professor of Economics
Kansas State University, USA**

Teaching is important and interesting! Teachers have the opportunity to positively influence students' careers and lives. This presentation will synthesize and summarize methods to enhance teaching and learning at the University level. Andrew Barkley is Professor and University Distinguished Teaching Scholar in the Department of Agricultural Economics at Kansas State University, where he has taught since 1988. Barkley teaches courses in the economics of agriculture and public policy. Barkley is a frequently-requested speaker on the topics of motivation, teaching, higher education, and agricultural and public policy issues. Barkley's research includes assessment of teaching and learning, economic evaluation of the wheat industry, and agricultural and public policy.
